The Lakeland Care District (www.lakelandcaredistrict.org), a regional long term care district delivering services to the elderly and adults with disabilities in Fond du Lac, Manitowoc, and Winnebago Counties, seeks **experienced social workers or human services professionals** to join its Care Management Services Team at the District's Offices in Oshkosh and Manitowoc.

The **Care Manager**, as part of an interdisciplinary team (IDT), provides comprehensive care management to frail elders, adults with physical disabilities and adults with developmental disabilities who are District members. The goal of the team is to promote the overall health and well-being of District members by providing high quality, member-centered, outcome-based, cost-effective care management. In collaboration with the Registered Nurse Care Manager, this individual is responsible for conducting assessments, assisting in the development and evaluation of care plans and coordinating care with informal and formal supports.

This position involves regular communication and collaboration with members (including home visits) and their families and providers. Individuals in this position typically work 40-45 hours per week **during regular Monday through Friday business hours.**

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in social work or human service related field.
- At least two years of experience working with elders or persons with disabilities.
- Proficiency with computers, computer programs, typing, and data entry.

- Ability to access members' homes which may or may not have accommodations for individuals with disabilities.
- **Employees work on teams with specialized target groups that include: Frail Elderly Adults, Adults with Developmental Disabilities, and Adults with Physical Disabilities (or any combination of the three groups). Relevant experience with one or any of these target groups in a community setting is desired.**
